<u>Bibs /Payment</u>	Each club representative is given a single envelope including the bibs for all registered club athletes at the registration desk. The registration has to be paid in CASH at the registration desk. Registration desk opens at 11:00.										
<u>Registration:</u>	Not later than 60 minutes prior to the scheduled start of event.										
<u>Competition site</u>	Synthetic track, spike length 6mm for track events, 9mm for jump events & javelin

- **when she/he is present at the prize money ceremony at 19:00 after completion of the last event** (if the athlete is not physically present at the ceremony, the prize money will be given to the next athlete in the order of the achieved performance scoring points)
- when she/he competed in senior events
